



Strengthen Responses to Sexual Violence

Funding for Sexual Assault Services	Lead efforts to maintain funding for sexual assault services.
Sexual Assault Kits	Support best practice proposals that improve the sexual assault kit system and responses to victims of sexual assault.
	Identify retention standards and timelines for storage and destruction of unreported kits.
Sexual Harassment	Introduce and support best practices that protect and advance response and prevention of sexual harassment.
Campus Sexual Violence	Support best practice proposals that preserve and advance title IX protections.
Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) Access	Support efforts to enhance access to quality SANE trainings, programing, and protocol response development.
Human Trafficking	Support efforts to improve access to services for survivors of human trafficking.

Advance Victim Protections

Statute of Limitations	Support efforts to increase access to justice through the expansion/elimination of statute of limitations on felony sex crimes. Remove language in SOL statutes that require a victim to file a report with law enforcement.
Sexual Assault Protection Orders	Lead policy efforts to remove barriers for victims in response to the Roake v. Delman decision. Increase protection order access for students enrolled in K-12 education by striking the student age limit of 18 years of age, as students 21 years of age may be enrolled.

Rape 3	Support policy that acknowledges the neurobiology of trauma by striking current language that places the burden on victims to show through their actions or words lack of consent.
Rideshare Safety	Support proposals that address and improve safety measures for rideshare customers.
Sex Offender Management	Support sound proposals which comprehensively address the sentencing, release, housing, and overall management of adult and juvenile sex offenders in order to improve the safety of victims and communities.
Crime Victims Compensation	Support maintenance of Crime Victims Compensation benefits, including those for sexual assault victims.
Victim Privacy	Support proposals that enhance and protect victims' privacy needs and rights.
Victims of Crime	Support proposals to improve services to victims of other crimes (such as homicide and assault).
